

Inox Wind to set up wind farms in Gujarat

Mumbai: Inox Wind (IWL), a subsidiary of Gujarat Fluorochemicals, on Thursday said it has bagged two contracts from Tata Power Renewable Energy (TPREL) for setting up 54 MW and 118 MW wind farms in Gujarat and Rajasthan, respectively.

"Inox Wind has been awarded two wind-farm project contracts of 54 MW and 118 MW in Gujarat and Rajasthan, respectively, by Tata Power Renewable Energy, a wholly owned subsidiary of Tata Power," a release issued here said.

The two companies have signed pacts which require IWL to supply, erect and commission 86 units of its 2 MW wind turbine generators (WTGs) in the two states. The Gujarat project is likely to be completed by June 2015, while the Rajasthan project will be completed in two stages, by March 2016. IWL will be responsible for site acquisition, project development, erection and commissioning, and also providing long term operations and maintenance of wind power projects, the release said. The Inox-Tata Power agreement comes at a time when several states in the country are reeling under acute power shortage.
